Our first week of July our theme is “camping”. We will make a campfire with hand prints, and make tents using fabric and paper towel rolls. Children will also explore in a tent in our dramatic play area.

**Tuesdays and Thursdays for the summer will be when children have the opportunity to engage in water play. Please remember on those days to pack a bathing suit and towel along with a change of clothes.**

During the following weeks we will focus on the “ocean”. We will discuss different textures such as sand and focus on ocean animals. We will explore with sand and seashells and how they feel. We will also be making a jellyfish, counting legs on an octopus, and decorating beach balls.

For the last week of the month our theme is “water”. We will focus on ***Rhode Island Early Learning Standard, Science Development*** . This will help children to learn how to plan and carry out investigations and collect, evaluate and communicate information .Children will engage in water play during this week to gain this knowledge. Also children will paint with watercolors and create colorful tornados using water and recycled bottles.
