This month we are working on the letters "G,H,I". the numbers 5,6 the color brown and the shape square. Our math/science goal is identifying numbers 5,6 and their quantity, making predictions and observing the outcome. Our language/literacy goal is identifying the letters G,H,I, and their sounds and to handle books with respect. Our physical health and motor development goal is to begin to understand proper nutrition. Our creative art goal is to show persistence when doing a project. Our social/emotional goal is to engage in a new experience with confidence. Our social studies goal is to become aware that they are part of a family. Our cognitive development goal is to be able to follow multi step directions

The first week we will be talking about proper nutrition and the foods that keep us healthy and strong. We will talk about the food pyramid and the different kinds of foods in each group, We will also be getting ready for our Thanksgiving feast; making crafts and decorations to make the room festive!
