Our curriculum is written in accordance to the RIELDS. Here are the goals we have set for this month. We will work on the letters P, Q, R, the numbers are 11, 12, 13, the color pink and the shape heart. Our math/science goal will be learning to use numbers to solve problems. Our language/ literacy goal will be to recall details from a read story. Our physical health goal will be to develop better coordination and balance. Our creative arts goal will be to engage in imaginative play with peers. Our social/emotional goal will be to show compassion and empathy towards others. Our social studies goal will be to compare similarities and differences. Our cognitive development goal will be to solve a problem with planned action

The first week of the month is Dental Week. We will be talking about ways to keep our teeth clean and healthy, proper tooth brushing and what foods are good or bad for your teeth. We will even try painting with a toothbrush! That should be interesting! Show us your smile!

The second week is Valentine's Day. We will talk about why we do special things for people we love. We will be making a special card, a Valentine Day bag and glittery hearts. At the beginning of the month, a list of classmates' names will be sent home. If you choose to send out Valentine cards, please make sure that each child gets one. Valentines will be passed out on February 14th at our Valentine's day party.

The third week is Multicultural Week. We will talk about different cultures and how their customs are similar/different to ours. We will make an African Maasai necklace and a Chinese goldfish kite. This should be an interesting topic!

We will read all our favorite books and will make a Cat in the Hat hat with our names on it, Red fish, Blue fish fish bowl, green eggs and ham and a THING 1 hat.
